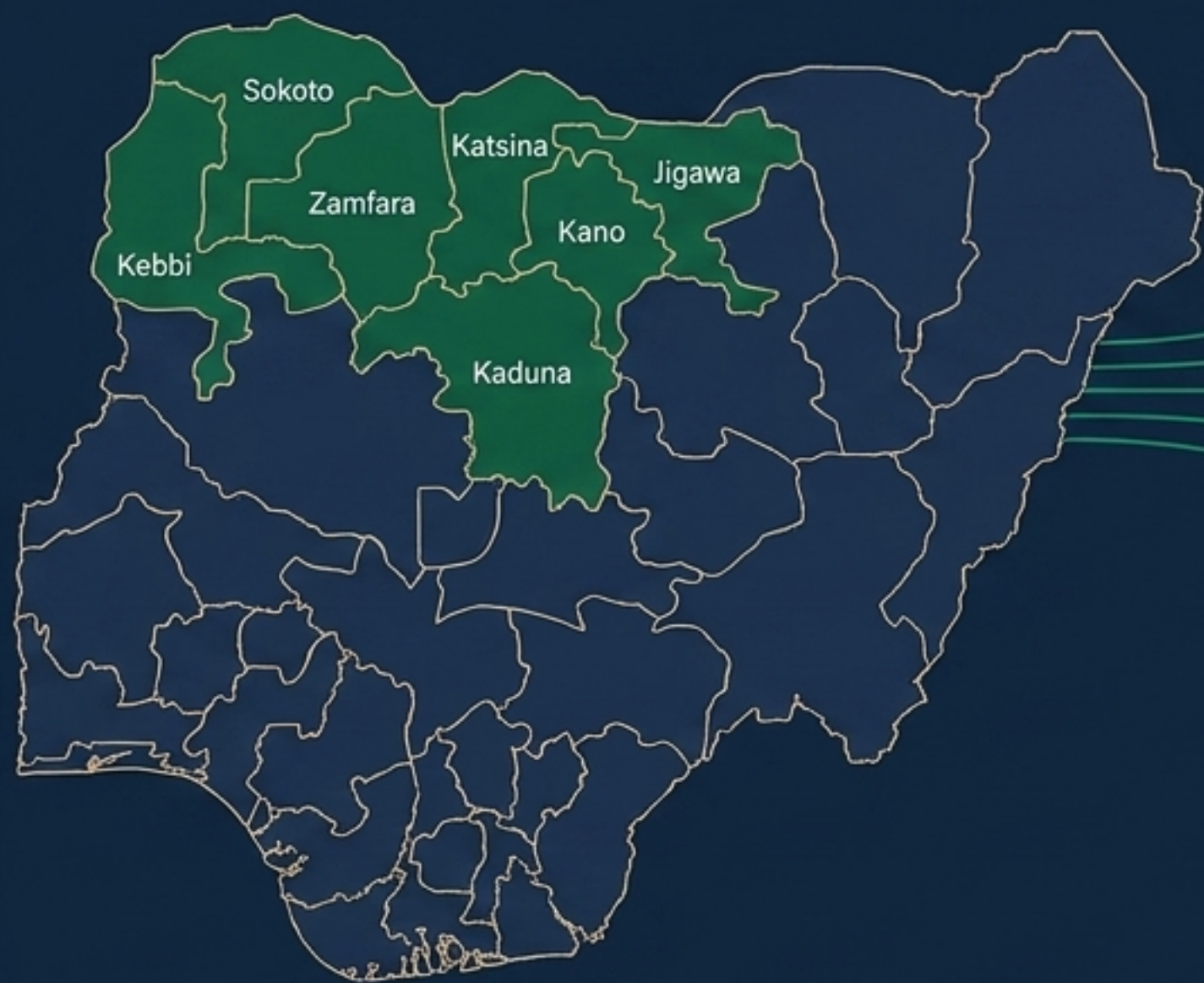
A Strategic Pivot from Vulnerability to Bankable Opportunity

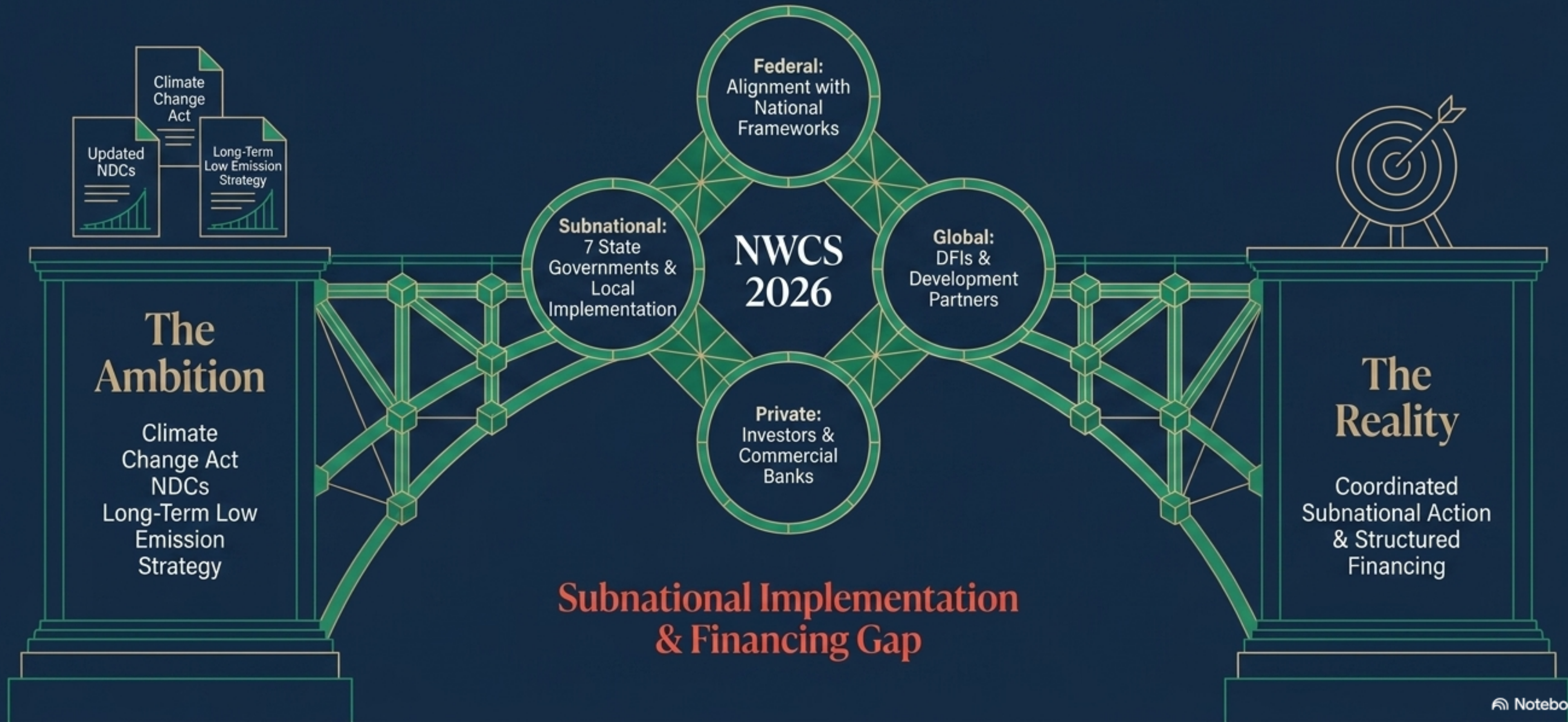

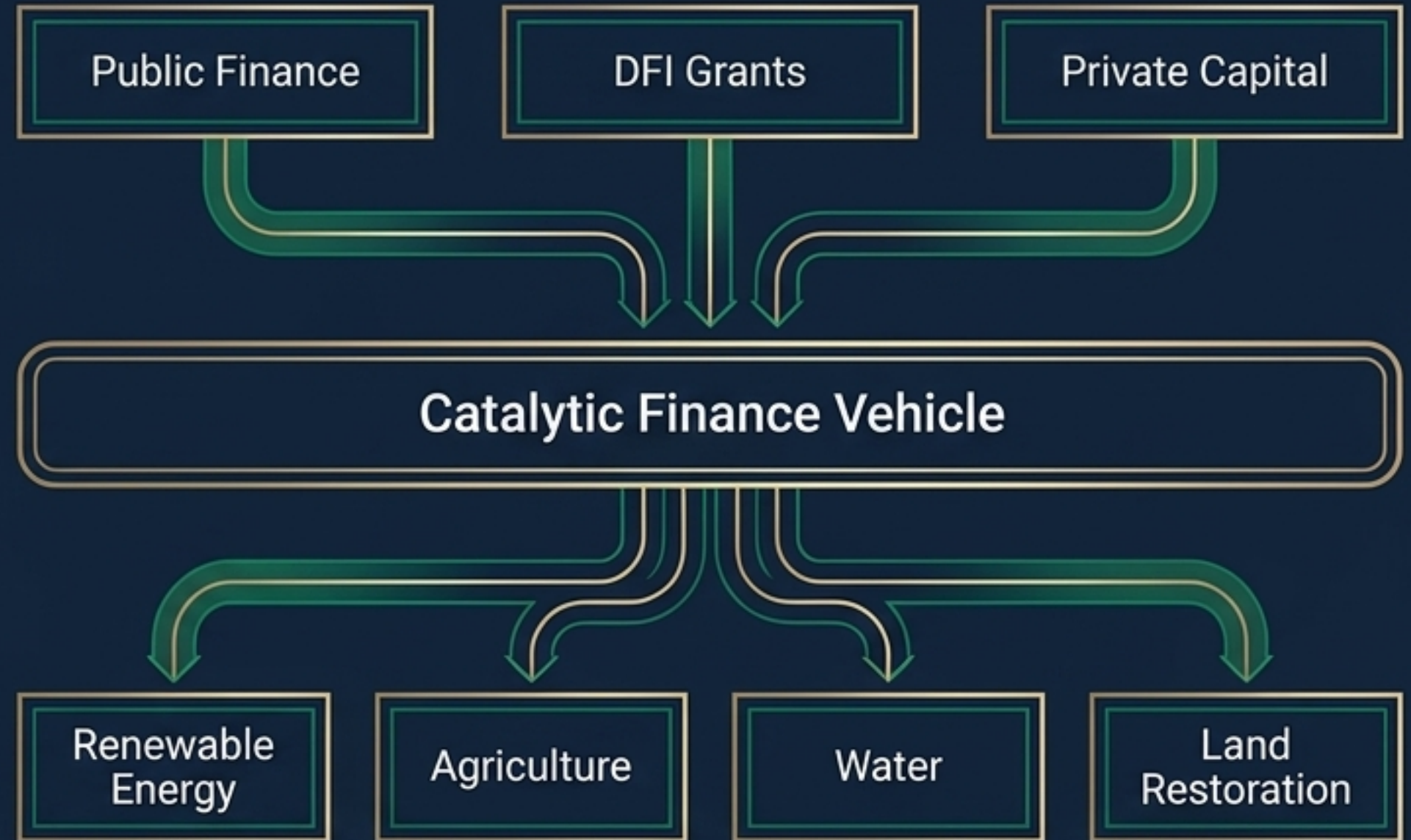

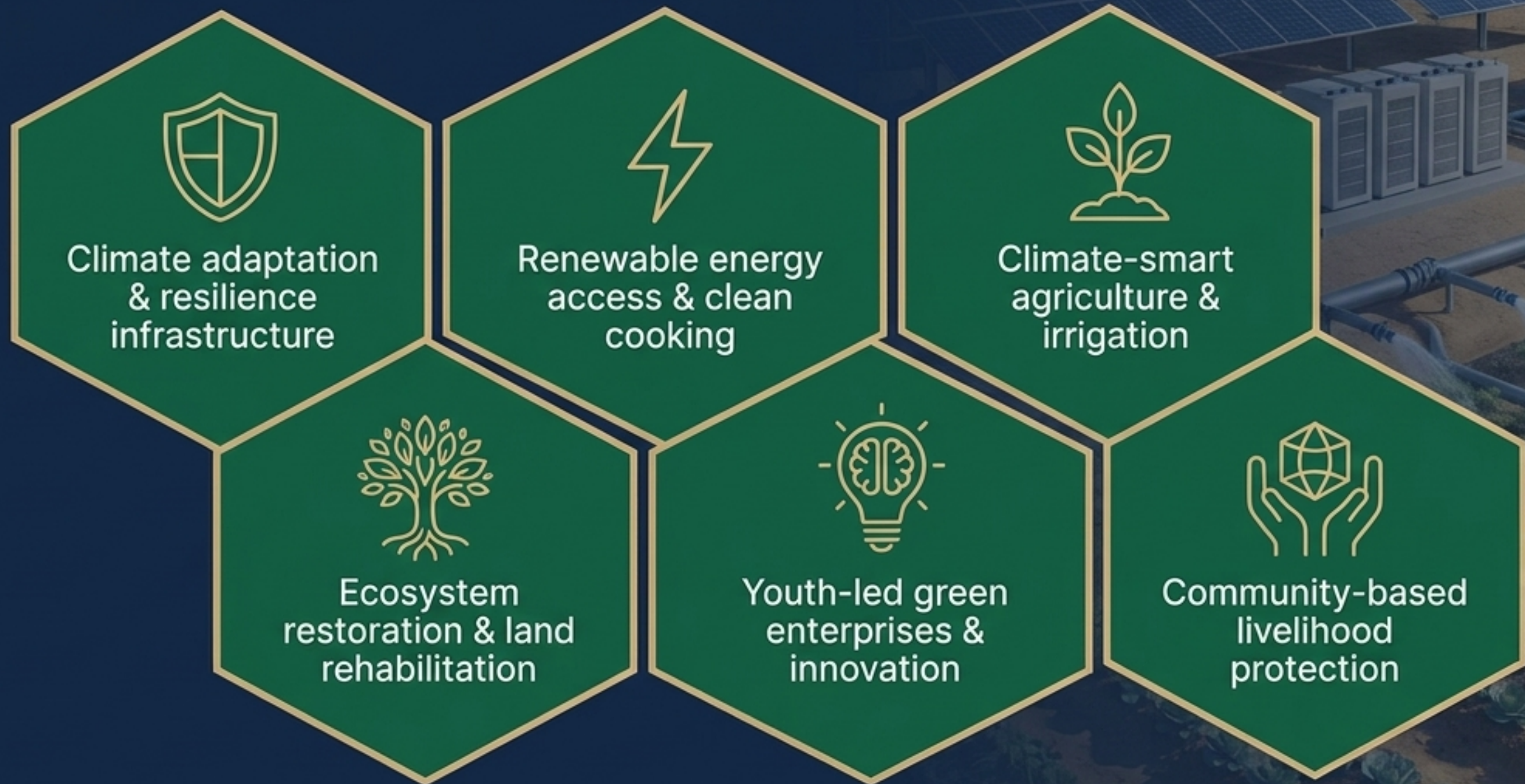
The Human Capital Engine

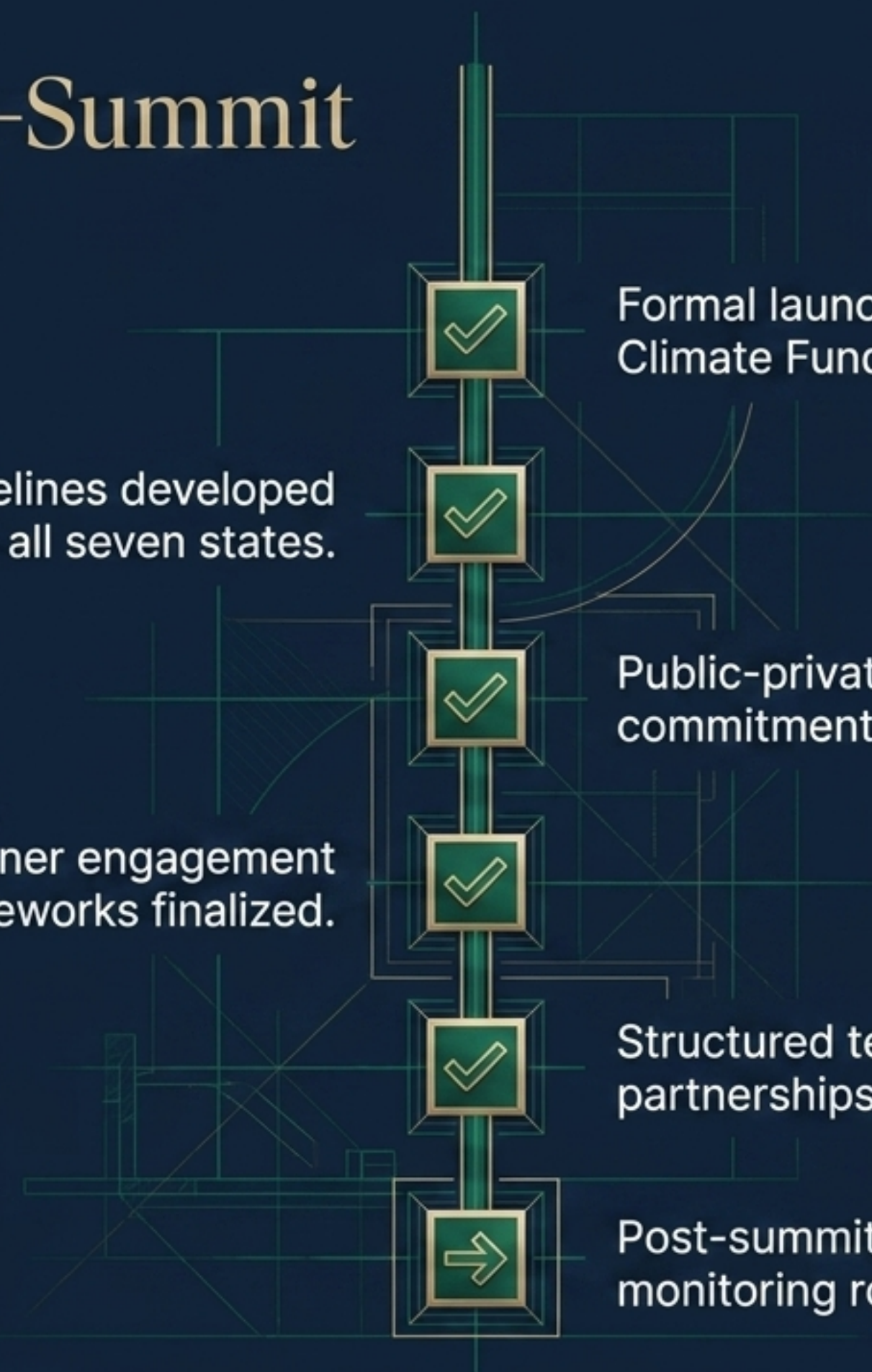
